

ECHA Consults Over Two Substances as SVHC



The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) has launched a consultation over the listing of two chemicals as substances of very high concern (SVHC). Comments are being accepted until April 15, 2024.

On March 1, 2024, the ECHA <u>launched</u> a 45-day consultation period for listing bis(α , α -dimethylbenzyl) peroxide and triphenyl phosphate as SVHC. If approved, the number of SVHC on the <u>Candidate List</u> will expand from 240 entries to 242 entries.

Highlights of the two substances are summarized in Table 1.
